MISUNDERSTANDING: THE DEVIL IS A MYTH



Discussion Questions:

- 1 What was your initial reaction after watching “FOXHOLE”? *Did it resonate with you? Why or why not?*
- 2 How did the Major contribute to the central message of the parable?
- 3 Reflecting on the parallels drawn between the soldiers in the trench and spiritual warfare; discuss the consequences of ignoring the reality of the devil in both the short film and in our personal lives. *How does denial or ignorance impact our ability to defend ourselves against spiritual attacks?*
- 4 The short film suggests that the devil is real and actively seeks to harm humanity. How does this understanding align with your beliefs or worldview? *How might this perspective influence the way you approach spiritual warfare?*
- 5 In what ways can we arm ourselves against the devil, as depicted in the short film? *What are some practical steps we can take to defend ourselves and others against the schemes of the enemy?*
- 6 How does the concept of community and teamwork play a role in spiritual warfare, as illustrated in the short film? *How can we support one another in recognizing and combating spiritual threats?*
- 7 The ending of the short film depicts the major falling victim to the enemy. What do you think symbolizes in terms of spiritual warfare and the consequences of denial or disbelief?
- 8 Reflect on a time in your life when you felt particularly vulnerable to spiritual attacks. How did you respond? *What did you learn from that experience?*
- 9 How can we apply the lessons learned from the parable of “FOXHOLE” to our everyday lives? *What practical steps can we take to remain vigilant and prepared for spiritual battles?*
